- **Advance courses for entrepreneurs.**

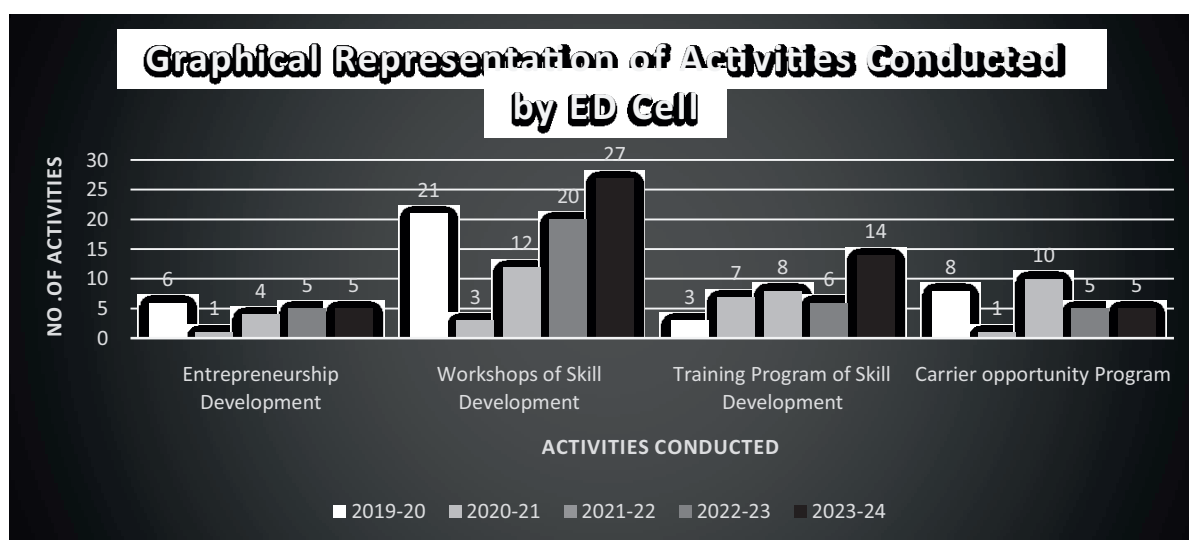

● Identification and Control of Agricultural Pests

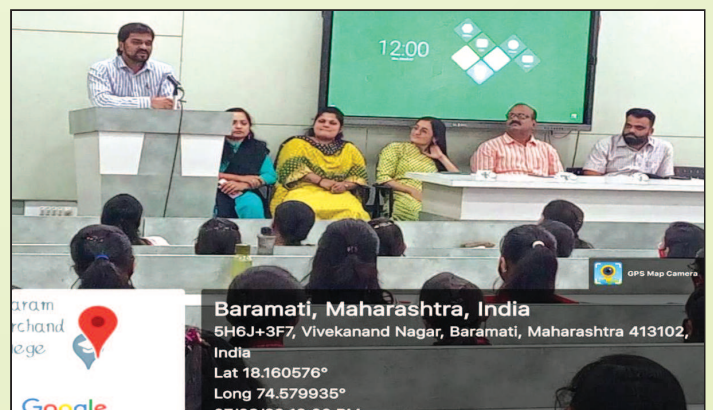
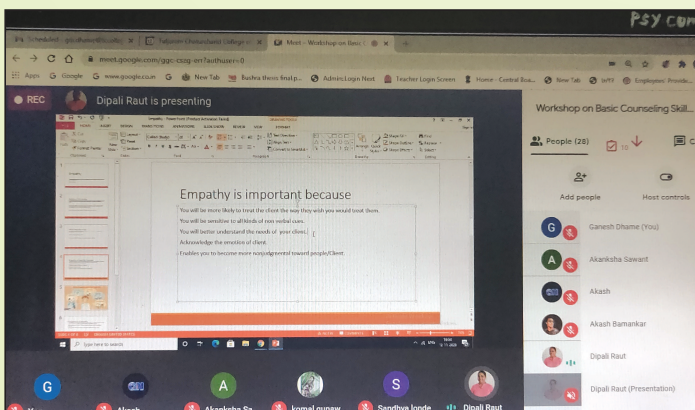
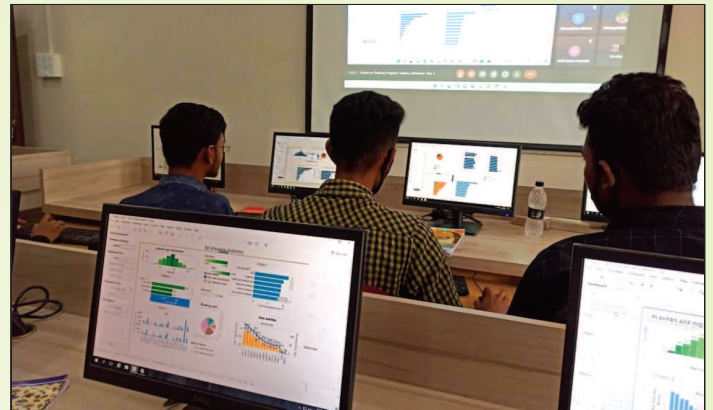
