



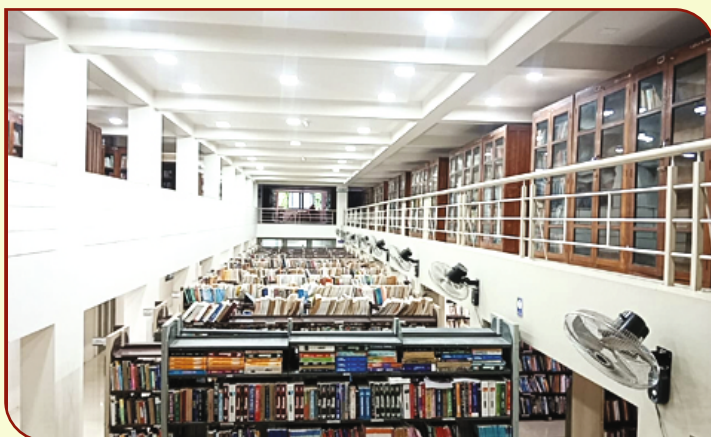
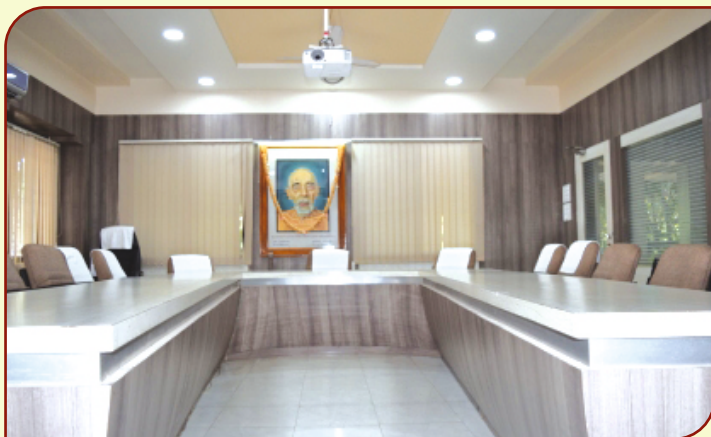

The 64 classrooms in the college with all facilities like ICT, fans, black boards of traditional and modern modes of teaching such as: LCD projectors.

Additionally, classrooms for the Media Programmes are equipped with audio-visual systems.

Research Block: (CIAR):

Centre for innovative and applied Research (CIAR) has been established to encourage the students and faculty members to undertake quality research work to address societal, state, national and global challenges. The CIAR is responsible for the development and implementation of research strategy of the institute. It assists to formulate strategic planning for research and executing the plan. It Co-ordinates academic management of the research of the institute as a whole, encourages faculty and departments to increase research grant from different funding organization in India, encourages national/international Collaborations. The Centre encourages faculty members to participate in research activities, publish their work and participate in national and international conferences to present the research data and generate new concepts in the emerging areas in the form of research outputs (as defined by research patents, papers, books, book chapters, and conference proceedings etc.).

The reading material are acquired by way of donations and purchased from UGC funds and college funds.

Department of Food Processing and Post Harvest Technology:

Tuljaram Chaturchand College, Baramati has started B.Voc degree programme in Food Processing & Post-Harvest Technology sponsored by UGC under National Skill Qualification Framework scheme with 50 intake capacity in 2014-15. In the year 2019-20, M.Voc. program was started to focus on vertical expansion of Post graduate degree and research level as provided under the UGC guidelines for Vocational education under NSQF with 24 intake capacity.

Department of Dairy Technology:

The Department of Dairy Technology was established in the year 2018-19. The Department of Dairy Technology offers an under graduate course of Bachelors in Vocation. This course is approved by UGC and affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University.

The duration of this course is 3 years. The Department observes and celebrates different commemorative days such as Milk Day, National Nutrition Week, Food Day etc.

Department of Retail Management:

The B.Voc in Retail Management Program is designed by the UGC as per National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) emphasizes on skill based education in consultation with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

This would enable the graduates completing B.Voc to make a meaningful participation in accelerating India's economy by gaining appropriate employment, becoming entrepreneurs.

Department of E-Commerce & Digital Marketing:(ECDM)-

The B.Voc.- E-Commerce & Digital Marketing programme curriculum of the Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science & Commerce (Autonomous) is developed and established in August 2019 for the dynamism in the industry practices, evolution in technology and the evolving expectations of key stakeholders viz. students, the industry and faculty members at large.

The B.VOC- ECDM programme facilitates learning in theory and practice of different functional areas of management and equips the students with an integrated approach to various functions of management.

Internal Quality Assurance Centre (IQAC) Office:

IQAC ensures quality culture as the prime concern for the Higher Education Institutions through institutionalizing and internalizing all the initiatives taken with internal and external support. Department of Gymnasium (Physical Education) was established in 1962. The college authorities made available 17 acres of land for the establishment of the gymnasium.

With the grant from the university and government as well as the investment of the society a vast playground was made ready, where a track of 400 mt. for running, volleyball court, basket ball court, football ground, and Kabaddi and Kho-Kho ground was made.

This is done so that the students can take full advantage of the facilities.

From 1962 till 2009 the players representing our college have brought many laurels at the University, National, and State levels for our college. The college had organized an India university Kho-Kho, Kabaddi competition. District-level competitions were also organized by the college. This fully equipped gymnasium over these years has always been a pride of honour for the college.

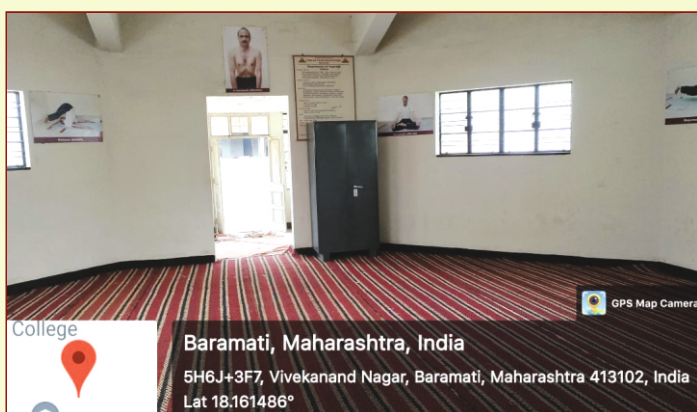
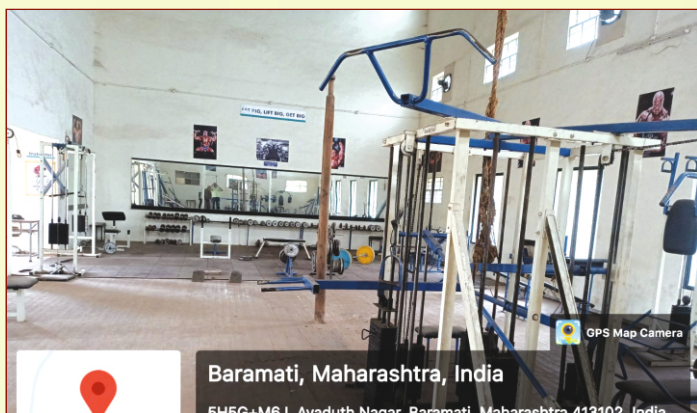
