Regular activities of NSS for academic year 2020-21 were started from 15th August 2020, inaugurated by Hon. Shri. Chandragupta Shah, Member, Anekant Education Society, Baramati and in auspicious presence of Hon. Shri. Jawahar Shah (Wagholikar), Secretary, Anekant Education Society, Baramati. On this occasion Honorable Members of Society, Prin. Dr. Chandrashekhar Murumkar, Vice-Principals, Programme Officers, all teaching and Non-teaching staff and Students were present.

1) **Covid-19 disaster management:** After announcing the **lock down period from March to June 2020**, about 300 NSS volunteers of our college carried out various activities such as Grocery distribution for needy people particularly workers related to sugar factories in their nearby areas, sanitizer and mask preparation and distribution, village sanitization program conducted by their home villages, making of video clips on covid-19 awareness, assistance to Asha workers.

2) **Pune-Pandharpur Virtual harit vari-2020:** Due to the Covid-19 pandemic situation, **03-07 July 2020** Virtual harit vari-2020 five days program announced by NSS Dept. SPPU, Pune. During this period NSS volunteers conducts various programs in their home village such as awareness program for cleanness, cleaning of premise, making and distribution of sanitizers and masks, covid-19 awareness programme namely spitting kills, survey, prohibition of open defecation etc. For the successful conduction of these activities nearly 200 volunteers took their participation.

3) **Can I help you:** During Covid-19 pandemic situation volunteers of NSS unit ready for helping for the banking process in which peoples to follow the rules such as making social distance, wear the mask and sanitize their hands.

4) **Police Mitra:** During Covid-19 pandemic situation, our NSS volunteers took their active participation to help local Police force as Police mitra to conduct lockdown period smoothly.

5) **Adaptation of Ten Families:** Covid-19 situation, NSS Dept. SPPU, Pune, was announced by each volunteer should adapt of ten families for their survey and awareness about covid-19. About 100 volunteers of our NSS unit actively participated for unique activity.

6) **Gandagi mukt abhiyan:** Through lock down period NSS, SPPU, Pune has declared the Gandagi Mukt Abhiyan for the period of five days 10-15 Aug. 2020. Various activities with the help of NSS volunteers, such as wall paintings, saplings plantation, mask preparation and distribution and sanitization were arranged and completed.

7) **Spitting Kills (Anti-tobacco pledge):** From March-20 to Jan.-21 NSS volunteers of our college under the guidance Dr. Vilas V. Kardile sir, took their active participation in awareness program of **Spiting Kills (Anti-tobacco pledge)**, organized by Sambhand foundation , New Delhi Pleased to announce Tuljaram Chaturchand College, Baramati has first college in Maharashtra that completed total points: 10000 in making awareness about the Spitting Kills in society with Sambhand foundation , New Delhi a NGO working in Anti Tabaco Mission.

8) **My Family My Responsibility:** NSS volunteers of our college follows the instructions given by the Government of Maharashtra such as use of mask, keep safe distance and use sanitizer or wash the hand with soap and water repeatedly. Along with this, unit of our college were conducted survey under the heading of '**My Family My Responsibility**' during 15/09-25/10/20. Under this programme our college NSS P.O.s appeal to volunteers to go their home place Grampanchayat, request to corresponding officers or Asha worker to help for the survey.

Under the survey, our volunteers goes to every home and collect the information of each family under the headings of- age, oxygen level with help of oxymeter, temperature, ask for their B.P., sugar or any other problems and also ask about their symptoms such as flu, cold, cough etc related to symptoms of COVID- 19. If any member from family have one or two symptoms of COVID-19, they requested go to for further checking to confirm as they have COVID-19 or not. The collected data is submitted to the corresponding officers. For this work nearly 80 volunteers survey nearly 2000 families of their home places.

9) **Anetant Lecure Series:** NSS unit of college and RUSA, Dehli was jointly organized online and offline five days Anekant lecture series on Youth's devotions for Atmanirbhar Bharat on 10-14 Feb. 2021. For this series lectures well known personalities of various fields were arranged and successfully completed. This lecture series is open for all students of the college so more than 600 students were actively participated.

10) **Pulse Polio Abhiyan:** On 31/01/2021, 15 NSS volunteers of college were actively participated for helping the medical officers during the pulse polio abhiyan.

11) **Road Safety Abhiyan:** The 07 day's road safety programme was inaugurated by Principal of College Dr. Chandrashekhar V. Murumker Sir. On this occasion Dr. Bhagwan Mali sir and Dr. Vilas kardile sir also present. NSS volunteers of college took their participation in road safety abhiyan by conducting awareness the peoples of the society at their home place.
