We make available maximum sporting events with standard equipment's and coaching facilities to our student. For kipping environmental balance we have planted lots of trees around the compound wall.

Our society feels proud of the achievements of our department. We had started with kabaddi, kho-kho, wrestling and athletics but now we offer 15 different sports and games to our students. Soon we are planning to construct multipurpose hall and swimming tank.
