

Memorandum of Understanding for Collaboration

AGREEMENT 1.

- 1.1. This agreement made and entered into on the 18th December 2021 between Department of Microbiology, Tuljaram Chaturchand (TC) College Baramati, Dist- Pune, Maharashtra established on 27/04/1962 in pursuance of the Bombay Public Trust Act-1950 and having its headquarters at Baramati, (herein after called TC which expression shall where the context so admits includes it's successor and permitted assigns)
- 1.2. Mangalam Agrotech (MA), having its registered office at Ambegoan (herein after called MA) of the other part.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the present Memorandum of Understanding are establishing the basis of cooperation between the participants to:

BACKGROUND 2.

- Whereas the TC has the supporting facilities, human resources in terms of faculties, researchers, and students desirous of undertaking teaching, research, development, and extension programs in the disciplines of Microbiology wish to undertake collaborative work with Mangalam Agrotech.
- 2.2. Whereas Mangalam Agrotech has the expertise in the manufacturer of biofertilizers.
- 23. Mangalam Agro tech promise to commit farmers and society for the benefit of healthy eating and sustainable farming growth by providing their technology and research-based unbeatable high standard organic inputs to enriches farmers lives with joy, healthy and wealthy future because that creates a positive impact on all individual, society, and world.
- 2.4. Faculties from TC and members from MA had meetings to discuss the common collaborative work to benefit the students and society complementing each other's work. Consequently, it was decided to have an MoU as a tool to facilitate joint efforts to achieve objectives of mutual interests of TC and MA.

SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT 3.

- Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- The Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in training methodology 3.2. so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- The interaction between Industry and College will give an insight into the latest developments /requirements of the industries;
- 3.4. Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party.
- 3.5. The industrial training and exposure provided to students through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth function from academic to

3.6. The Second Party will provide its Labs/ Workshops/ Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

3.7. The Second Party will train the students of the First Party on the emerging technologies to bridge the gap in skill and make them ready for industry.

- 3.8. The Second Party will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.
- 3.9. The Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs.
- 3.10. The first party will provide their expertise for the troubleshooting in the industrial process
- 3.11. The first party will provide purpose in infrastructure assistance in terms of laboratory for the research

STUDENTS TRAINING 4.

- 4.1. The TC and MA will provide the laboratory expertise for the conduct of undergraduate (UG), postgraduate (PG) training work necessary to enhance skills.
- 4.2. The MA will not have any financial liability towards the provision of fellowship/scholarship to the students.
- 4.3. The period of work and number of students per discipline shall be decided mutually by TC and MA.
- 4.4. The Head of TC and the CEO of MA will settle any differences/policy issues arising out of the implementation of this agreement after mutual consultation.
- 4.5. TC will organize various workshops on Entrepreneurship Development and MA will Conduct practical training on Entrepreneurship Development
- 4.6. TC and MA jointly assist in the placement of trained students

RESPONSIBILITIES OF TC AND MA 5.

- 5.1. TC and MA shall ensure access to the facilities to be used for project activities to concern students without restrictions on time whenever necessary.
- 5.2. The access to the lab facilities wherever necessary may be facilitated by TEMPORARY ENTRY CARDS that can be used throughout the project period.
- 5.3. TC and MA shall undertake the work on the collaborative training as per the schedule of work mutually agreed by the parties.
- 5.4. TC/MA shall provide all the basic facilities, to each other for the fulfillment of the training under the agreement.

CONFIDENTIALITY 6. Information as may be vital to the interest of the Institutes/Company, or security/defense of the country is not parted with any other party.

FINANCIAL AGREEMENT As a general principle, funding for the exchange of such personnel shall be based on a 7. reciprocal sharing of costs:

MODALITIES OF COLLABORATION 8.

TC and MA shall jointly identify centers/locations for carrying out studies/activities of any products emerging from collaborative projects and draw up protocols for such trials/ studies/ activities. The TC and MA shall undertake/assist/ co-operate with each other to carry out trials/studies/activities as per the protocols drawn up.

EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION, TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT 9.

- Cooperation under this Memorandum of Understanding is effective from the date of its 9.1 signature. Unless otherwise extended by both Participants decision, in writing, this Memorandum of Understanding is applicable for a three year period.
- The agreement shall be deemed to expire on completion of the period as in provision 9.2 unless extended by both parties.
- During the tenure of the agreement parties hereto can terminate the agreement either for breach of any of the terms and conditions of this agreement or otherwise by giving a 9.3 (Three month) notice in writing to the defaulting party, failure of either party to terminate the agreement on account of breach or default by the other shall not constitute a waiver of that party's right to terminate this agreement.
- 9.4 In the event of termination of the agreement, the right and the obligations of the parties hereto shall be settled by mutual discussion.

AMENDMENT OF THE AGREEMENT

- 10.1 No amendment or modification of this agreement shall be made unless the same is made in writing by both the parties and their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this agreement. The modification/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed unless otherwise agreed to ASSIGNMENT OF THE AGREEMENT.
- 10.2 The right and/or liabilities arising to any party to this agreement shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

USE OF NAME 11

The Parties agree not to use each other's names in any advertising or other form of publicity without the prior written consent of that Party. However, the Parties agree in advance that each may use the name of the other in announcing this MoU.
