Report of the Tree Plantation under <u>Aaazadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav</u>

This year, the college is also celebrating the <u>'Aaazadi Ka Amrut</u> <u>Mahotsav'</u> along with the nation on completion of 75 years of Independence. The College is going to conduct a series of programmes for celebrating 75 years of independence. The first event of this series of programmes was conducted through the Annual Tree Plantation Drive of the Department of Economics.

This is the fourth year in row wherein the Department is planting trees under this drive. First Year we planted trees in Bharanpur village in Baramati Tehsil and for last two years we planted more than 200 Tamarind Trees in Aasu Village in Phaltan Tehsil.
