MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Pune 413115. The first Party represented herein by Dr. Atul A. Baravkar, Principal, ADT's Shardabai Pawar Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research, Shardanagar (hereinafter referred as 'First Party').

AND

T. C. College, Baramati-413102, The second party, and represented herein by Dr. C. V. Murumkar, Principal, T. C. College, Baramati (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party"). (First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:
 - ADT's Shardabai Pawar Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research, Shardanagar
- B) Second Party is a Higher Educational Institution named: Anekant Education Society's Tuljaram Chaturchand College, Center for Innovation and Applied Research, Tal: Baramati, Dist: Pune- 413102
- C) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- D) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training and Education in quality control and advanced research and teaching techniques in academics.
- E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- F) T. C. College, Baramati, the Second Party is engaged in Business, Skill

Development in the fields of quality control and advanced research and teaching techniques in academics and related fields.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of both Parties, providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry.
- 1.3 General terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, research and competitiveness of an academic and research activities. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3 Academic Training & Visits: Institution-Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the Institution; both parties will permit the Faculty and Students of each other's to visit their Institutions and also involve in Institutional Training Programs. The Institution training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. Both parties will provide its Labs / Workshops / Institution Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with both parties.
- 2.4 **Skill Development Programs:** Both parties will train the students of each other's on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.5 **Guest Lectures:** Both parties will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of each other's on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.6 **Faculty Development Programs:** First Party & Second Party will help each other for faculty development as per the Industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.7 **Research Collaboration:** Both parties have agreed to carry out joint research activities in the respective field. Both parties will actively help each other for doing their quality research work
- 2.8 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein
- 2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of both the parties to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealtseparately.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **T. C. College, Baramati** the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of **T. C. College, Baramati** the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and Second **Party** are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Baramati.
