D. Research centers. Beside traditional courses we seek to develop and introduce need based, value added, skill based and career oriented new courses. (hereinafter referred as 'First party', the institution of which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject of the context shall include its successor – in-office, administrators and assigns).



Darekar, President, Rotary Club of Baramati [Rotary year2022-23 RID3131 Club No.15488], (hereinafter referred as "Second Party" organization which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject of the context shall include its successor – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First party and second party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'parties' and individually as 'party')

Whereas:

- A) First party in higher education institution named: **Department of Economics, Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Baramati, (Autonomous) Dist. Pune – 413102.** First party and second party are believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunity.
- B) The parties intent to corporate and establish center of excellence to channelize their efforts on corporation with in area of social work projects, skills based training, education and research, consultancy.
- C) Both parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest;
- D) Rotary club of Baramati, The second party is the Rotary foundation helps rotary members to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace by improving health, providing quality education, improving the environment, and deviating poverty.



Now there for, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MOU, the parties here to agree as follows


Clause 1: Co-operation

- 1.1 Both parties are united by common interest an objectives, they shall established channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within Department of Economics, T.C. College, Baramati and its related wings .the parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another
- 1.2 First party and second party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the capabilities of the faculty, students, alumni of the first party providing significant inputs to them in collaborating on life changing and sustainable social project of the second party
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The parties shall co-operate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'definitive documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The terms of definitive documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the parties on the subject matter hereof.

Clause 2: Scope of the MOU

2.1 Student Centric: The faculty members, alumni, and building graduates from the institutions could play the key role in social work and transformational projects. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhanced their social sensitivities, skills and knowledge.

2.2 Establishment Of Activity Based Rotary Club On Campus: both the parties may agree to establish and support for the future social endeavors of collaborative learning, research, entrepreneurship, incubation, industry, connect, placement support, certification courses, SDP, FDP, MDP, conferences, seminars, workshops colloquiums, consultancies and other activities with mutual agreement time-to-time, in the premises of the either parties with ICT and resources support. The said MOU is the foundation and expansion of Rotary club Baramati. The formal standard operating procedure (SOP) shall be discussed and finalize through mutual agreement on the same by parties.



2.3 Curriculum Design: Second party will give valuable inputs to first party in teaching/training methodology, evaluation and suitable customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the social / cultural and industrial scenario meaningfully.

2.4 Learning programs and visits: Organization and institution interaction will give and insight into the latest development / requirements of the society; the second party to permit faculty and students of the first party to visit the member groups and also inverse in training / learning programs for the first party .This exposure provided to students and faculty members through this association will built confidence and prepare the students to have smooth and competitive transition from academic to Working career .The second party will provide its faculties and community infrastructures for the hands on training of the learners enrolled with the first party and vice versa.

2.5 Internships and Placements of Students: Second party will actively engage to assist the delivery of the internship for students and placements of students of the first party into internship/job, as per University internship policy.

2.6 Research Innovation and Consultancy : Both parties are agree to carry out the joint research ,innovation and consultancy activities in the field of social work community based cultural engagements and related fields.

2.7 Skill Development Programs: Second party to train the faculty, resources, alumni, and students of first party on the emerging skills in order to bring the competency gap and make them industry-ready. Skill based training in 360 degree personality development and social entrepreneurship.

2.8 Guest Lectures : Second party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the identified stakeholders of the first party on the technology trends and in house requirements. Both parties agree jointly to utilize each other's resources , faculty , alumni , and students to organize and deliver guest sessions , and seminars with pre-communicated considerations (role, schedule, coverage, duration, financial implications, etc.).

2.9 FDP and SDP : Second party to train the faculties of first party for imparting industrial exposure/training as per the industrial requirements considering the national occupational standards in concerned sector if available both parties agree jointly to utilize each other's resources, faculty, alumni, students to organize and deliver faculty development programs(FDPs), student development programs (SDP), as well as industrial training with pre-communicated consideration (role, schedule, coverage, duration, financial implications, etc.).

2.10 Approach to external funding agencies: Either Party can apply for the external governmental / non-governmental funding agencies (SPPU, DST, AICTE, etc.), terms and conditions, the separate definite documents shall prepare with all consideration(role, schedule, coverage, duration, financial implications, etc) for mutual understanding and transparency.

2.11 Permissions: Both parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and license of whatsoever nature required for offering the programs on the terms specified herein.

2.12 No Financial Commitment: There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Baramati, (Autonomous) Dist. Pune – 413102.** the first party to take up any program mentioned in the MOU, and vice versa .If there is any financial consideration it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY


3.1 Nothing contain in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication , Estoppels or otherwise, create in either party any right, title, interest or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copywriters and designs) of the other party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

4.1 To begin with, both the parties agree to sign the MOU for 3 years. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms. Both parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implies, on behalf of the other party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, not represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party to pledge the other Parties credits or to extends credit on behalf of the other party. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act,1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts Baramati city.



5.2 Commencement, Duration and Termination

This linkage agreement shall enter into force on the date of its signing for **three years**. This linkage agreement shall remain in force by mutual consent, unless either Party notifies in Writing of its intension to terminate this linkage agreement two months in advance or existence of either party.

Any natural calamities may also cease this Linkage agreement.
