The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of S.Y.B.A Semester-III, aligning it with the guidelines of the pattern 2022, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Dr. S. Kombade proposed the of the application of economics in the course financial planning portfolio management. He also suggests there should be proper link in designing the syllabus of history of economic thought. Dr. Shinde A. requested the exclusion of some chapters from the public finance. Furthermore, both Dr. S. Kombade and Dr. Shinde A. suggested modular framework should be used while designing the chapter and subpoint. The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of S.Y.B.A Semester III.

Furthermore, it was decided to maintain uniformity in the number of units across all courses, with a total of three units for the 2-credit courses and five or six units for the 4-credit courses.
