





MINUTES OF THE MEETING

As per the Notice no. 53, dated 29/05/2023, issued by the college, the meeting of Board of Studies in Defence and Strategic Studies was successfully held on 6th June 2023 at 12:00 pm in the Department of Defence Studies, T. C. College, Baramati. The meeting took place online, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Dr. Devidas V. Bhosale, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Defence and Strategic Studies, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 5th April 2023.

The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were approved and confirmed.

2. To consider and approve the course structure of the First Year UG (Sem-I and II) according to the NEP 2020.

The BOS has discussed the course structure of the FYBA as per the NEP 2020 credit structure guidelines. Taking into consideration the valuable suggestions provided by the BOS members, necessary modifications were made to the course structure. After careful consideration and thorough discussion, the final course structure has been determined, ensuring compliance with the NEP 2020.

Considered and Approved.

3. To design and approve the curriculum in accordance with the NEP 2020 for FYBA (Semester-I) from the academic year 2023-2024.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of FYBA Semester-I, aligning it with the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Prof. Dr. C.B. Bhange proposed the addition of the Reconstruction of the Indian Forces topic in the course DEF-101-MJM Defence Organization of India Part-I, as well as recommended the inclusion of a new topic focusing on the Intelligence Agencies. Prof. Adinath Londhe requested the inclusion of the Theatre Command and Nuclear Command in the same course. In DEF-102-MJM Cdr. Dr. Bhushan Dewan proposed the addition of the evolution of war in each topic in the course. Furthermore, Brig. Hemant Mahajan requested the inclusion of the Nathu-La and Cho-La

clash and Sumdorong Chu standoff in DEF-102-MJM course. Prof. Adinath Londhe requested the inclusion of the Cultural, Political, and Economic Situation in Maharashtra before Chhatrapati Shivaji in DEF-117-OE course. Cdr. Dr. Bhushan Dewan proposed the addition of the topic regarding Maratha Navy. Brig. Hemant Mahajan requested the inclusion of the role of media in National Security topic in DEF-121-VSC course. Furthermore, Brig. Hemant Mahajan requested the inclusion of the Role of social media in Reporting chapter in the same course. Dr. Ramesh Raut requested the inclusion of the Cyber Security Comparative in DEF-126-SEC course.

The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of FYBA Semester I.

Major mandatory subjects, namely DEF-101-MJM: Defence Organization of India Part-I and DEF-102-MJM: Indian art of War post 1947 Part-I ; the open elective courses (OE), including DEF-116-OE: Key Concept of National Security Part-I and DEF-117-OE: Maratha Military System Part-I; the vocational skill course (VSC), DEF-121-VSC: Basics of Defence Journalism Part-I; the skill enhancement course (SEC), DEF-126-SEC: Basics of Cyber Security Part-I; the value education course (VEC), DEF-135-VEC Peace and Harmony Studies Part-I; and the Indian Knowledge System (IKS), DEF-137-IKS: Indian Military History.

Furthermore, members have discussed the objectives and course outcomes. Finally, it was agreed that the revised curriculum would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.

4. To introduce MOOC Certificate courses from SWAYAM platform for the S.Y.B.A and T.Y.B.A as per 2022 pattern

According to the guidelines provided by the IQAC of the college, the BOS conducted a comprehensive review and identified three best MOOC courses from the SWAYAM platform related to the subject of Defence and Strategic Studies. Detailed discussions were held on each of the identified MOOC courses, considering their applicability and usefulness to the students of SYBA and TYBA. Subsequently, all the courses were approved, and it was determined that all courses would be submitted to the IQAC, based on the requirement and availability of courses.

i) To consider the feedbacks and suggestions provided by the alumni and students of UG and PG classes while designing the syllabus of FYBA and MA/MSc.


