MINUTES OF THE MEETING

As per the Notice no. 207, dated 15/09/2023, issued by the college, the meeting of Board of Studies in Philosophy & Logic was successfully held on 23 Oct, 2023 at 8:30 pm in the Department of Philosophy & Logic, T. C. College, Baramati. The meeting took place both offline, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Mr. Krushnat Nagare, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Philosophy & Logic, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the previous BOS meeting .

The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were approved and confirmed.

2. To design and approve curriculum of S.Y.B.A Semester IV (2022 pattern) to be implemented from the academic year 2023-2024.

Chairman of BoS presented the first draft of the syllabus for SEM IV (2022 pattern). The BoS discussed the syllabus thoroughly. The paper named Symbolic Logic, Philosophy of Indian Saints, Indian & Western Philosophy, Jain Philosophy & Skill Enhancement Course Title (Ethics in Human life) were discussed and approved.

3. To design and approve curriculum of F.Y.B.A.Semester II (2023 pattern as per NEP-2020) to be implemented from the academic year 2023-2024.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of FYBA Semester-II, aligning it with the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members.

The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of FYBA Semester II.

Major mandatory subjects, namely PHI-151-MJM: Introduction to Ethics (4 credits) and PHI-152-MJM: Introduction to Western Philosophy; Minor subject PHI-161-MN: Social Philosophy & LOG-161-MN: Scientific Method; the open elective courses (OE), including PHI-166-OE: Logic and its Application and PHI-167-OE: Philosophy of Religion (Advance); the vocational skill course (VSC), PHI-171-VSC: Applied Yoga; the skill enhancement course (SEC), PHI-176-SEC: Philosophical Counselling.

5. Any other matter with the consent of Chairperson.

In the Meeting the Chairman shared his views on the restructuring of U.G. syllabus. The subject expert suggested some recommendations into the course structure, content, title of the course, exam, structure, resource material and referencing style. According, the structure and course content and examination pattern have been unanimously fixed in the meeting.
