### MINUTES OF THE MEETING

As per the Instructions received from Administration of the college and Notice no. 246 dated 04/10/2023, issued by the college, the meeting of the Board of Studies in Sanskrit was successfully held on 21/10/2023 at 11:00 AM in online mode. During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the agenda. Students feedback was collected and appropriate suggestions were incorporated in the syllabus. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting held on 8th June 2023:

The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were read, approved and confirmed.

2. To design and approve curriculum of SEM-II (2023 Pattern as per NEP-2020) and SEM-IV (2022 Pattern) to be implemented from academic year 2023-24:

Chairman of BoS presented the first draft of the syllabus for SEM-II (2023 Pattern as per NEP-2020) and SEM-IV (2022 Pattern). The BOS discussed the syllabus thoroughly.

While discussing the paper named 'संस्कृत अंतरंग', Dr. Pankaja Waghmare suggested addition of कर्णभारम् or उरुभङ्गम्. Other members supported her opinion. Dr. Ambarish Khare suggested reducing the content as the syllabus looks time consuming.

While discussing the paper with the title 'प्राचीन भारतीय गणितशास्त्र परिचय', Dr. Bharati Balte suggested adding the point related to Vedic Scholars in Course Outcomes. Dr. Mugdha Gadgil suggested addition of Vedic references of Ancient Indian Mathematics. Miss Rupali Wadekar suggested addition of Introduction of Leelavati Text and it's linguistic style of explanation. Dr. Ambarish Khare explained his views and suggestions about course objectives and course outcomes. Special Invitee Mr. Tejas Kulkarni shared his opinion and experience about teaching Lilavati Text.

First draft of the paper named 'संस्कृत भाषाप्रवेश' was discussed and approved by the members without any changes in the content.

While discussing the paper named संस्कृत परिचय (प्रगत) Prajwal Kamble suggested omission of मृगपक्षिशास्त. Dr. Pratima Waman suggested addition of various Ancient Indian Scientific Terminologies as an introductory part of science in sanskrit. Dr. Bharati Balte suggested considering chapter प्राचीन शास्त्रीय परिचय from गीर्वाणभारती (a textbook published earlier by SPPU, Pune). Dr. Ambarish Khare suggested addition of आयुर्वेदिक दिनचर्या & जनपदध्वंसः.

Taking into consideration the valuable suggestions provided by the BOS members, necessary modifications were made to the course structure. After careful consideration and thorough

discussion, the final course structure has been determined, ensuring compliance with the NEP 2020. Summary of the papers discussed and approved by the board is as follows-
