3. To design and approve curriculum of TYBCOM Semester V (2022 pattern) to be implemented from the academic year 2024-2025.

Dr. Vivek Bale, the Chairman, proposed the subject of designing the structure for the Third Year UG programs (Semesters V) in accordance with the guidelines provided by the college. He also requested approval of the curriculum of the T.Y.B. Com Semester-V (2022 pattern) Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) syllabus to be implemented from the academic year 2024-2025.

As per the 2022 pattern credit structure, it was decided by the college academic council that from 2024-25 in 2022, pattern syllabus skill enhancement courses (SEC) practical subjects for Semester V must be introduced and implemented. Dr. Bale showed the syllabus of useful subjects.
