# COLLABORATION

#### 1. AGREEMENT

- 1.1. This agreement made and entered into on the November 2021 between Department of Botany, Tuljaram Chaturchand (TC) College Baramati, Maharashtra established on 27/04/1962 in pursuance of the Bombay Public Trust Act-1950 and having its headquarters at Baramati, (herein after called TC which expression shall where the context so admits includes it's successor and permitted assigns)
- 1.2. Nymphaea and Nelumbo established in 26/03/2019 having its farm at Badlapur, Mumbai (herein after called AC) of the other part.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Whereas the TC has the supporting facilities, human resources in terms of faculties and students desirous of undertaking teaching, research, development, and extension programmes in the disciplines of Botany is desirous of undertaking collaborative work with AC and provide facilities and resources for field training.
- 2.2 Whereas AC has the expertise in the hybridization in water lily's and lotus and methodologies for growing, preservation and selling skills of aquatic plants.
- 2.3 Faculties from TC and experts from AC had meetings to discuss the common collaborative work to benefit the students and society complementing each other's work. Consequently, it was decided to have a Collaboration as a tool to facilitate joint efforts to achieve objectives of mutual interests of TC and AC.

Now therefore in consideration of premises and mutual convenience herein after content, the TC and AC hereby agree as follows:

### 3. SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

3.1 TC and AC may offer opportunities to the other for activities and



- programs such as guest lecture, training of students that will foster a collaborative relationship.
- 3.2 Specific Activities: Specific activities and programs implemented under the authority of this Collaboration and as decided from time to time on the topics of mutual interest of Department of Botany of TC and AC shall be subject to availability of funds and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives. The institutions contemplate implementation of programs or activities such as:
  - a. Joint educational and training activities.
  - b. Exchange of expertise and students for lectures and discussions.
  - c. Exchange of academic materials and other information.
  - d. Special, short-term training programs.

#### 4. STUDENTS TRAINING

- 4.1 The TC and AC will provide the expertise for the conduct of undergraduate (UG), and Postgraduate (PG) training work necessary to enhance skills.
- 4.2 The AC will not have any financial liability towards the provision of fellowship/scholarship to the students.
- 4.3 The period of work and number of students per discipline shall be decided mutually by TC and AC.
- 4.4 The Head of TC and the proprietor of AC will settle any differences/policy issues arising out of implementation of this agreement after mutual consultation. Their decision will be final.

#### 5 RESPONSIBILITIES OF TC AND RC

- 5.1 TC and AC shall ensure access to the facilities to be used for project activities to concern students without restrictions on time wherever necessary.
- 5.2 The access to the field wherever necessary may be facilitated by TEMPORARY ENTRY CARDS that can be used throughout the project period.
- 5.3 TC and AC shall undertake the work on the collaborative training as per schedule of work mutually agreed by the parties.
- 5.4 TC/AC shall provide all the basic facilities, to each other for fulfillment of the



training under the agreement.

## 6. CONFIDENTIALITY

Information as may be vital to the interest of the Institutes/Company is not parted with any other party.

#### 7. FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

As a general principle, funding for the exchange of such personnel shall be based on a reciprocal sharing of costs: Traveling, accommodation and daily expenses of the participating students/faculties required for visit/meetings under this agreement will be borne by the respective institute/company as per the prevailing rules and regulations. If such meetings are not sponsored by third party funding agencies. Each institute will provide assistance and/or the necessary letters of invitation.

#### 8. MODALITIES OF COLLABORATION

TC and AC shall jointly identify centers/ locations for carrying out studies/activities and draw up protocols for such trials/ trainings/studies/ activities. The TC and AC shall undertake/ assist/ co-operate with each other to carry out field trials/training studies/activities as per the protocols drawn up.

## 9. EFFECTIVENESS, DURATION, TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

- 9.1 The agreement shall be effective from the (date of signing/specify events) and shall recur in force for a period of Three years from said date.
- 9.2 The agreement shall be deemed to expire on completion of the period as in provision unless extended by both the parties.
- 9.3 During the tenure of the agreement parties here to can terminate the agreement either for breach of any of the terms and conditions of this agreement or otherwise by giving a (Three month) notice in writing to the defaulting party, failure of either party to terminate the agreement on account of breach or default by the other shall not constitute a waiver of that party's right to terminate this agreement.
- 9.4 In the event of termination of the agreement the right and the obligations of the parties there to shall be settled by mutual discussion.


