MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

UMESH KAMBLE, Founder and CEO (hereinaster referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators andassigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

- First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named: Anekant Education A) Society's, Tuljaram Chaturchand College, Baramati, Pune-413102,
- First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation B) between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhancedopportunities.
- The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation C) within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for D) advancing their mutual interest.
- Farm To Fork Solutions the Second Party is engaged in Business, E) Manufacturing, Skill Development, Education and R&D Services in the fields of consulting FOOD, DRUGS and COSMETICS and related fields

Farm To Fork solutions is a growth oriented organization run by visionary group of experienced Food Technologist, Pharmacist, Cosmetologists and F) diversified experts from leading institutes. We aspire to act as a connecting link amongst the Academia/ Research Organizations and various levels of the Food Chain (e.g., Farmer, Manufacturer, End Consumer, etc.) and pharmacy & cosmetic industries so as to enable the technology to reach to the stakeholders.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1. CO-OPERATION

- Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote 1.1 and advance their respective operations within the Institutionand its related wings. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2. SCOPE OF THE MOU The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. 2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills andknowledge.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenariomeaningfully. Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs

The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career.
